



#### BUNKHOUSE STYLE ACCOMMODATION

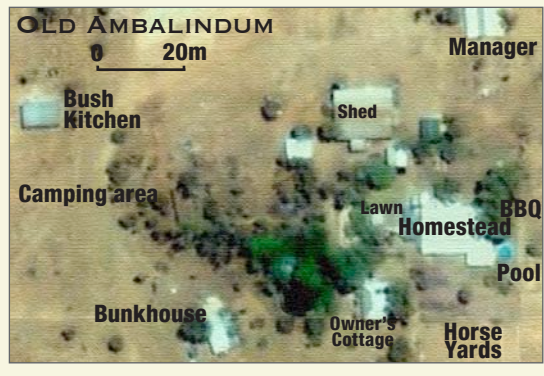
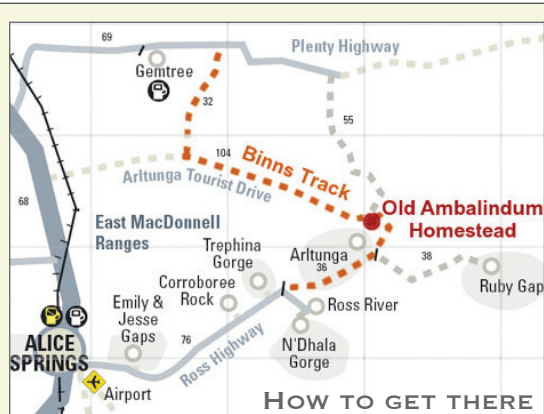
Close to the homestead are the recently re-furnished workers quarters. There are five separate bedrooms, each with two new super-size single beds (bunk style) and a bar fridge. All the bedrooms open onto a large air-conditioned common room, eat-in kitchen and lounge area.

#### CAMPING

There are camping sites for tents, camper-vans and off-road caravans, all with access to power and water, shower room and toilet. The camping ground offers both gravel and grassed areas.

#### BUSH KITCHEN

The Bush Kitchen contains a slow combustion stove, sink and washing facilities. There's also a bush barbecue area with facilities for camp oven cooking. And next to it is a shower and toilet block where you can shower under the stars.



#### HOW TO GET THERE

*Old Ambalindum* is 1½ hours east of Alice Springs located in the 'Arltunga Loop' tourist road on the newly promoted 'Binns Track'.

Take the Ross Highway east from Alice Springs for 70 km (all sealed) then turn left onto the gravel Arltunga Tourist Road (also sign-posted as the 'Binns Track').

After another 33 km you pass the old Arltunga Bush Pub (currently closed) on the left, keep straight on and follow the 'Binns Track' signs to Ambalindum.

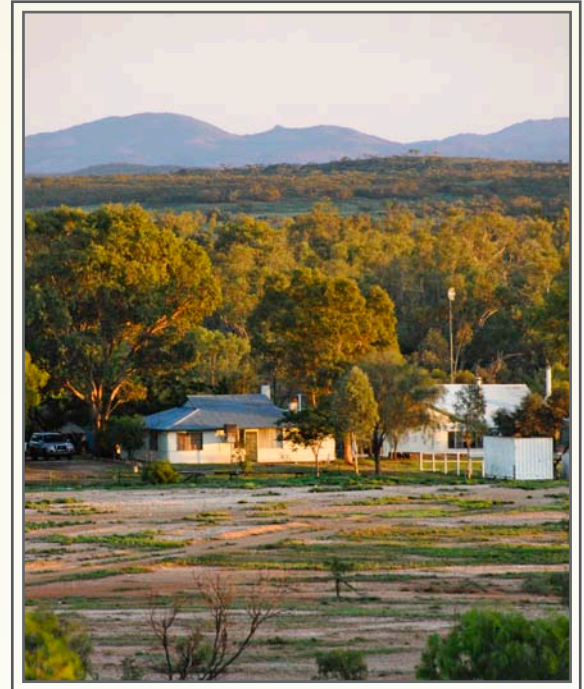

## SPEND A WEEK OR A WEEKEND AT OLD AMBALINDUM

While you're there you can enjoy living on your 'own' station without any of the hassles of managing the stock, checking the fences, fixing the bores, or doing the accounts!

Ambalindum Station is a working cattle station, situated approximately 135 km North East of Alice Springs, and is one of the original cattle stations settled in Central Australia. At well over 3,000 square kilometres, the station and its immediate surrounds feature some of the most spectacular scenery in Central Australia.

The *Old Ambalindum* Homestead is the focal point of local tourism activities. A range of accommodation is available, from camping sites and van sites to bunkhouse quarters, as well as the air conditioned comfort of the historic *Old Ambalindum* homestead itself.

## FOUR WHEEL DRIVING EXPERIENCE

Passing through widely varied terrain on Ambalindum are hundreds of kilometres of private roads and tracks, and they offer rare opportunities for the 4WD enthusiast. Rugged ranges to rolling plains, deep gorges to river



crossings (though they're almost always dry and sandy), the tracks vary from graded station access roads to very rugged and rocky tracks that are rarely used and a test of 4WD skills.

Detailed area topographical maps are available that show all private tracks, with GPS points marked for bores, dams and other identifiable features.

## WALKING AND MOUNTAIN BIKE RIDING

Close to the Old Ambalindum Homestead, there are several options for walking or mountain bike riding. Mapped and marked trails that vary in length give visitors a choice of options from relatively flat and easy to quite steep and rugged trails.
