



Jazz on the Slab

Saturday, March 20th

at Old Ambalindum Homestead.

Arrive when you like, jazz from 4:30pm

Bring a hamper, look around the historical homestead and from 4:30pm spend the late afternoon listening to jazz and leaping about to the music. Old Ambalindum is a working cattle station of over 3,000 sq. kms set among some of the most spectacular scenery in Central Australia.

And if you wish to stay overnight, then choose between the homestead, the bunkhouse or the camping ground (normal rates apply).



How to get there

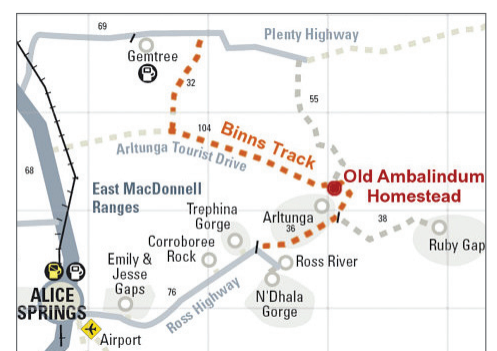
Old Ambalindum is 1½ hours east of Alice Springs located in the 'Aritunga Loop' tourist road on the newly promoted 'Binns Track'.

Take the Ross Highway east from Alice Springs for 70 km (all sealed) then turn left onto the gravel Aritunga Tourist Road (also sign-posted as the 'Binns Track').

After another 33 km you pass the old Aritunga Bush Pub (currently closed) on the left, keep straight on and follow the 'Binns Track' signs to Ambalindum.
